## RESOLUTION NO. 2013-01

**WHEREAS**, the Board has earlier approved that code entitled "Proposed Ethical Standards of Conduct for Law Professors" subject however to consultation with a representative number of law deans;

**WHEREAS**, in the Consultative Meeting of the members of this Board and a good number of law deans on March 20, 2013 at the Pamantasan ng Lungsod ng Maynila, the Proposed Ethical Standards of Conduct for law Professors was submitted to them with the suggestion that they study the contents of the document and submit their comments or objections in writing to the Board within 15 days from March 20, 2013;

**WHEREAS**, no comment was received by this Board within the period stated in the preceding paragraph; and

**WHEREAS**, this document is on the Agenda of today's Regular Board Meeting;

**NOW THEREFORE**, on motion duly seconded, resolved as it is hereby resolved to approve the Ethical Standards of Conduct for Professors of Law;

**RESOLVED FURTHER** that this document shall be registered with the University of the Philippines Law Center,


printed and published in a newspaper of general circulation in the Philippines.
