LEB MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

Subject : **ADVISORY ON WHO SHOULD TAKE THE SEPTEMBER 23, 2018 PHILSAT**

With the nearing closure on August 19, 2018 of the ONLINE REGISTRATION for the Philippine Law School Admission Test (PhiLSAT) to be administered on September 23, 2018, the following are strongly advised to register and take the test:

1. Those who have not taken the PhiLSAT but were conditionally admitted/enrolled in the basic law course in the 1st Semester of AY 2018-2019.
 - Taking and passing the September 23, 2018 PhiLSAT is the principal condition for their conditional admission/enrolment.
2. College graduates and graduating college students at the end of the AY 2018-2019 who are intending to seek admission as freshmen law students in AY 2019-2020.
 - The September 23, 2018 PhiLSAT is the primary test schedule of the PhiLSAT for those intending to seek admission in the basic law course in AY 2019-2020. September 23, 2018 PhiLSAT examinees have a chance to retake the PhiLSAT in April, 2019 in case they are unsatisfied with their rating/score.
3. Those who passed the April 2017 PhiLSAT and whose Certificate of Eligibility (COE) will be expiring in AY 2018-2019 but intend to seek admission for law studies in AY 2019-2020.
 - The PhiLSAT COE is valid for two (2) academic years following the test. The PhiLSAT COE for the April, 2017 test is valid only for admission in AY 2017-2018 and 2018-2019.

The following may also retake the September 23, 2018 PhiLSAT if they are intending to seek admission in the basic law course anytime in AY 2019-2020 and AY 2020-2021:

- Those who have failed in previous PhiLSAT tests; and
- Those who passed in the previous PhiLSAT tests.
