Subject: **IMPORTANT REMINDERS CONCERNING CONDITIONALLY ENROLLED FRESHMEN LAW STUDENTS IN AY 2019-2020.**

- 1.0. *Conditional Enrollment Permit* – Administrators of law schools, particularly the deans and the registrars, are reminded to require all conditionally enrolled freshmen law students admitted in the 1st Semester of AY 2019-2020 to submit the Conditional Enrollment Permits (CEP) issued by the Legal Education Board (LEB). Students without CEP should be instructed to immediately apply for their CEP from the LEB. - 2.0. *September 29, 2019 PhiLSAT* – Deans and registrars are requested to remind all their conditionally enrolled freshmen law students admitted in the 1st Semester of AY 2019-2020 to take the 6th PhiLSAT scheduled on September 29, 2019. Conditionally enrolled freshmen law students cannot continue with their law studies in the 2nd Semester unless they take the 6th PhiLSAT. The online registration for the test is up to August 16, 2019 through the website <https://www.philsat.com.ph>.
