Subject: **REMINDER ON SUSPENSION OF CLASSES IN LAW SCHOOLS DUE TO INCLEMENT WEATHER, FLOODING AND OTHER CALAMITIES/DISASTERS.**

1. To prevent untoward incidents and avoid confusion in times of inclement weather and flooding during the rainy season, everyone is reminded to observe LEB Memorandum Order (LEBMO) No. 18, Series of 2018, which provides for the guidelines on the suspension of classes in law schools in times of inclement weather, flooding, and other calamities/disasters;
2. Pursuant to LEBMO No. 18, law schools are automatically covered by the suspension of classes in the tertiary level declared by national and local government authorities in compliance with the police power exercised by national and local government officials. Law school administrators and faculty members are advised against holding classes despite orders or declarations from the concerned authorities;
3. Law schools are directed to adopt or update, and publicize their regulations/policies on suspension of classes, which should be consistent with LEBMO No. 18 for the information of their respective constituencies.
