MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 52

ADVISORY ON THE PHILSAT (February 26, 2020)

During its meeting on February 24, 2020, the Legal Education Board *En Banc* decided to defer the administration of the Philippine Law School Admission Test (PhiLSAT) scheduled this coming April, 2020 for reasons of public health concern arising from the COVID-19 and logistical considerations. For purposes of admission of new first/freshmen year students in the law program leading to the *Juris Doctor* degree in the 1st Semester of the Academic Year 2020-2021, law schools will be permitted to admit on conditional enrollment applicants who have not yet taken the PhiLSAT, subject to taking the next PhiLSAT in September, 2020. The LEB will issue additional guidelines to facilitate the admission of conditional enrollees.

Meanwhile, consultations on the proposed revisions to LEB Memorandum Order No. 7, Series of 2016, will continue.
