SUBJECT: Junior Scholars Symposium on Private International Law

The Legal Education Board endorses to all law deans, professors and students the invitation by the University of the Philippines Law Center, with support of the Integrated Bar of the Philippines, for the upcoming public symposium, **Junior Scholars Symposium on Private International Law: Foreign Law Solutions to Philippine Law Problems** to be held on May 10 and 15, 2021.

The webinar aims to exhibit case studies on cutting edge issues in Private International Law, such as the Philippine legal recognition of: (1) Foreign divorce, (2) foreign intellectual property rights, (3) foreign criminal conviction, (4) foreign same-sex marriage, (5) foreign surrogacy agreements, (6) gender reassignment under foreign law, (7) parentage and child custody rights under foreign law, and (8) foreign law governing the capacity and family rights of dual citizens and the successional rights of their heirs.
