SUBJECT: GOJUST Funding Facility for Clinical Legal Education Program

The Legal Education Board endorses to all Law Deans and Law Clinic Directors the funding facility for Clinical Legal Education Program (CLEP) which has been recently launched by the Governance in Justice (GOJUST) Programme for the benefit of law schools facing challenges in the implementation of the CLEP.

The funding program is designed to support the operationalization of CLEP by providing up to One Million Pesos (PhP 1,000,000.00) per year for two years to schools which would be recipients of the grant. It is open to public and private legal education institutions (LEIs).

The deadline for expressions of interest is **17 October 2021**, and for proposals on **3 November 2021**. Please see the attached announcement from GOJUST for details.

All LEIs are greatly encouraged to maximize this opportunity to achieve a successful CLEP implementation in their schools.

The Governance in Justice (GOJUST) Programme Launches Funding Facility to support the Clinical Legal Education Program (CLEP) of the Supreme Court

GOJUST has launched the start of the funding program for the CLEP which stands to benefit many law schools that are challenged to implement their own CLE programmes. The grant facility is making available approximately PHP 1 million per year for two years for the successful law school whose grant application will be approved by GOJUST.

The funding facility is open to public law schools or private laws schools whether stock or non-stock corporations. NGOs that can manage the funds for the law schools are also eligible to apply.
