**SUBJECT: Gender Sensitivity Training for Law Students**

The Legal Education Board and the University of the Philippines College of Law Gender Law and Policy Program (UP GLPP) invite all first- and second-year law students to the second iteration of the Gender Sensitivity Training entitled ***Gender and Development 101: A Webinar on Gender Sensitivity for Law Students***, to be held on April 09, 2022 from 8:30 AM to 12:00 PM.

The webinar aims to capacitate law students by heightening their awareness of and sensitivity towards gender issues in the legal practice, the academe and the larger society of law students in the country; and provide as well an introductory course on gender-related concepts and principles, such as: a) Gender 101; b) Gender-fair language; c) Gender advocacy; and d) Anti-sexual harassment laws. At the end of course, participating law students would be able to 1) identify gender issues in the legal practice, in the academe, and in the larger society; 2) explain gender-related concepts and principles; 3) recognize the various forms of gender discrimination, sexual harassment, and sexually related abuses and 4) identify the ways and means to properly respond to incidences of discrimination and sexual abuse.
