**Legal Education Board Memorandum Circular

SUBJECT: Externship Course for Placement Agencies

The Legal Education Board endorses to all Law School Deans and Law Clinic Directors, the **Externship Course for Placement Agencies** under the CLEP Training Program. This is a project of the Legal Education Board, in partnership with the Supreme Court Oversight Committee on the Implementation of the Revised Rule 138-A, and the Philippines Association of Law Schools, with project support from The Asia Foundation and the U.S. Department of State Bureau of International Narcotics and Law Enforcement Affairs (DOS-INL).

This course will be offered to law clinics' partner placement agencies and organizations offering externships for law students practitioners and will cover two (2) major topics: 1) Externships Basics, the Essential Elements of a High-Quality Externship Program; and 2) Placement Excellence, the Factors to Consider in Providing a High-Quality Learning Experience for Student Externs.

These topics are to be delivered by partner experts from the Vermont Law School.

The course will be conducted using both asynchronous (through the CLEP Training Program LMS) and synchronous modalities (through a webinar-type session). The asynchronous modules will be available starting **August 01, 2022**. Details of the synchronous sessions will be sent out to the registered participants.
