SUBJECT: 2nd Environmental Law Faculty Training

The Legal Education Board invites all environmental law professors and lecturers to the upcoming **2nd Environmental Law Faculty Training: Train-the-Trainers Program**, delivered in partnership with the Asian Development Bank, to be held on **October 27-28, 2022**, through **Hybrid setup** (in-person and via Zoom online conferencing platform). The in-person sessions will be held at the ADB Headquarters, Ortigas Center, Mandaluyong City.

This blended learning program will focus on the developments of pedagogy and environmental law teaching in the post-COVID world. Participants will also be exposed to the work being done on the Regional Model Environmental Law Curriculum.

At the end of the training program, participants are expected to: 1) be updated on the global best-practice concepts of pedagogy; 2) be introduced to the Regional Model Environmental Law Curriculum; 3) be able to integrate learnings into the teaching of the Environmental and Natural Resources Law course prescribed in the Revised Model Law Curriculum; and 4) network and share knowledge with other environmental law professors and teachers in the Philippines.
