**MEMORANDUM FROM THE OFFICE OF THE CHAIRPERSON**

**TO : LAW SCHOOL DEANS, ADMINISTRATORS, LAW CLINIC DIRECTORS, SUPERVISING LAWYERS**

**SUBJECT : NEEDS ASSESSMENT ON LEGAL AID CLINICS**

The Legal Education Board invites all Law School Administrators, Clinic Directors, and Supervising Lawyers to participate in the ***Needs Assessment Study on Legal Aid Clinics***, being conducted by the **Association of Law Students of the Philippines (ALSP)** in partnership with **The Asia Foundation (TAF)**, **Philippine Association of Law Schools (PALS)** and the **Legal Education Board (LEB)**.

The Needs Assessment Study aims to determine the existing issues and challenges besetting the legal aid clinics in the country and the best means of addressing them through developmental activities. Specifically, it aims to 1) identify the institutional needs and other causes that encumber the establishment of law school legal aid clinics in the country; 2) examine the impact of legal aid clinics in terms of service to the community; 3) categorize the needs of law student practitioners in their preparation for the practice of law; and 4) further assist agencies by providing context on the status of law school legal aid clinics in the country.

The outcomes of the study will be presented in a plenary session during the first (1<sup>st</sup>) *Philippine Clinical Legal Education Summit* to be held in Grand Hyatt Manila, 35<sup>th</sup> Street, Taguig City on December 1-3, 2022.
